**Section A: OCCUPATIONAL PROFILE**

**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

Hotel and Hospitality room attendants clean the rooms, hallways and lobbies of hotels, motels and resorts.

**MAIN DUTIES:**

Hotel and Hospitality room attendants perform some or all of the following duties:

- Sweep, mop, wash, wax and polish floors.
- Dust furniture and vacuum carpeting and area rugs, draperies and upholstered furniture.
- Make beds, change sheets and distribute clean towels and toiletries.
- Attend to guests' requests for extra supplies.
- Stock linen closet and supplies area.
- Clean, disinfect and polish kitchen and bathroom fixtures and appliances.
- Clean and disinfect public areas such as changing rooms, showers and elevators.
- Pick up debris and empty trash containers.
- Wash windows, walls and ceilings.
- Report and store lost and found items.
- May provide basic information on facilities.
- May handle complaints.

**EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS:**

- There are no specific education requirements for occupations in this unit group.
- Certification for housekeeping room attendants or similar certification may be required by some employers.
