DELIVERY DRIVERS

Section A: Occupational Profile

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Delivery drivers drive automobiles, vans and light trucks to pick up and deliver various products. They are employed by dairies, mobile caterers, gravel and cement businesses and courier companies.

MAIN DUTIES:

Delivery drivers perform some or all of the following duties:

- Operate and drive automobiles, vans and light trucks to pick up and deliver various products, such as bakery and dairy products, gravel and cement and packages and parcels
- Perform pre-trip inspection of vehicle
- Sell products over established routes and accept or make payments for goods
- Record information on pick-ups and deliveries, vehicle mileage, fuel costs and any problems encountered
- May communicate with central dispatch using cellular telephone or citizens' band (CB) radio.

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Completion of secondary school may be required.
- A driver's licence appropriate to the class of vehicle being driven is required.
- One year of safe driving experience is usually required.
- On-the-job training is provided.
- Eligibility for bonding and transportation of dangerous goods (TGD) certification may be required for delivery drivers.
