SASKATCHEWAN IMMIGRANT NOMINEE PROGRAM (SINP)

ASSESSMENT RATING – CRITICAL IMPACT EMPLOYEE

In order to be considered under the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program (SINP), a Critical Impact Employee applicant must have a job offer from a Saskatchewan employer that has been approved as a Critical Impact position and meet a minimum of 60 points in the overall assessment rating. Before submitting a SINP application, the applicant should complete the assessment rating to determine whether they are likely to qualify. In addition to this application, the employer must also submit a Critical Impact Position request for review by the SINP.

A Saskatchewan Immigration Advisor will assess the application based on the same factors and must assign at least 60 out of 100 points overall for consideration under the Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program. If there is a difference between the points the applicant has assigned and the Immigration Advisor, the Advisor’s assessment will prevail. You may be asked to submit additional information to assist the Advisor’s final assessment. Point scores may change without notice.

For each factor, enter your factor assessment score in the “SCORE” box.

FACTOR 1: OCCUPATION

The employer’s application to designate a Critical Impact Position must be approved.

Some applicants will be required to meet provincial, national and/or industry association regulatory and licensing requirements before being allowed to work at a particular occupation. The applicant may be required to meet the requirements prior to consideration by the SINP or have their educational, training or occupational credentials reviewed by a qualification assessment agency or an occupational accreditation organization in Saskatchewan or Canada.

Points are awarded based on the number of years experience the principal applicant has in the intended occupation.

FACTOR 4: EDUCATION

Points are awarded for the applicants' highest level of education and/or highest level of training:

Completed at least two years of full-time post-secondary training or apprenticeship training but do not have trade or occupational certification.	5	
Completed at least two years of full-time post secondary training or apprenticeship with a trade or occupational certification.	8	
Completed three to four years of university studies with an undergraduate degree.	8	
Completed post-graduate university studies and acquired a Masters or Doctorate degree or acquired a post-degree professional designation.	10

FACTOR 5: ADAPTABILITY

Assessment of the applicant's potential for settlement in Saskatchewan.

Applicant or spouse has immediate family living in Saskatchewan as Canadian citizens or permanent residents. A family member would include adult children, parents, grandparents, brothers, sisters, aunt, uncle, niece, or nephew with whom the applicant would have contact and support.	5	
Applicant has been recruited or is supported by a community or cultural group or regional economic development authority.	5	
Applicant can demonstrate successful employment in an occupation other than the occupation identified in Factors #1 and #2.	5	
Applicant has studied at a Saskatchewan University or technical school for a minimum of three years.	3	
Applicant has worked in Saskatchewan for at least one year (not including work undertaken while attending an education institution.)	3

FACTOR 6: SPOUSAL EMPLOYMENT

Points are awarded for arranged employment of a spouse accompanying the applicant based on the options outlined below.

FACTOR 7: AGE

Points are awarded based on the age of the applicant on the date the application is received.

FACTOR 8: LANGUAGE ABILITY [Note: Answer *only* section A) or B)]

The principal applicant is to identify the language where they have the greatest fluency in reading, speaking and writing. The applicant may also note the level of language ability in both languages; however, only the highest scoring language ability score will be considered in the total assessment score. Applicants may be requested to submit further assessment documentation respecting language.

DEFINITIONS

Fluent: The applicant has an excellent command of the language in a wide range of social and employment situations. The applicant can communicate with ease in an employment situation.

Well: The applicant can communicate reasonably well in relation to familiar situations, such as in the area of professional expertise and personal settings.

With Difficulty: The applicant has only minimal knowledge and can only speak, write or read a few words. The applicant would require language training.
